## Act 139 Report to Vermont Standards Board Advisory Council on Literacy 16 October 2024

As previously reported, the Council is transitioning from Act 28 to Act 139 directives. During this meeting, council members reviewed past practices and explored new directions.

## **Updates**

During the 18 September 2024 meeting of the *Advisory Council on Literacy*<sup>1</sup>, the committee met members of the AOE team and Interim Secretary Zoie Saunders, who presented an overview of the *Vermont Reads* literacy initiative and Act 139.

The AOE representatives responded to questions about the following items:

- Parental Notification
- Training and focus for learners beyond grade 3 (anticipated professional development to address adolescent literacy)
- Facilitation guides for literacy modules
- Literacy module and RFP references for evidence-based resources

The Advisory Council on Literacy is using the following checklist to identify implementation needs around Act 139:

- Time to plan implementation
- Time to implement evidence-based instruction and assessment practices
- Professional learning on evidence-based instructional practices
- Professional learning on literacy assessment and data driven decision making
- Resources on evidence-based instructional practices
- Resources on literacy assessment and data driven decision making
- Funds for professional learning
- Funds for instructional materials
