

Indicator 3: Assessment

A. Not currently used in statewide or local APR.

B. Participation for Students with IEPs

Percent of children with IEPs participating in the assessment, calculated separately for reading and math. The participation rate is based on all children with IEPs, including children with IEPs enrolled for a full academic year and those not enrolled for a full academic year.

$$\text{Indicator 3 Measure B Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children with IEPs participating in the assessment}}{\text{Number of children with IEPs enrolled during the testing window and eligible to test}} \times 100$$

C. Proficiency for Students with IEPs

$$\text{Indicator 3 Measure C Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children with IEPs scoring at or above proficient}}{\text{Number of children with IEPs who received a valid score}} \times 100$$

Percent of children with IEPs scoring at or above proficient, calculated separately for reading and math.
