

Indicator 5: Education Environments (ages6-21)

- A. The percent of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for 80% or more of their day.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure A Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs in the regular classroom for 80\% or more of the day}}{\text{Total number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs}} \times 100$$

- B. The percent of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for less than 40% of their day.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure B Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs in the regular classroom for less than 40\% of the day}}{\text{Total number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs}} \times 100$$

- C. The percent of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are placed in Separate School, Residential or Homebound / Hospital settings.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure C Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs in separate schools, residential facilities, or homebound/hospital placements}}{\text{Total number of children aged 6-21 with IEPs}} \times 100$$

It should be noted that the sum of measures A, B & C may be less than 100%, as there are other educational environments that are not the subject of these APR measures.
