

## FY22 ARP Homeless I Subgrantees

On April 23, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education (USED) announced the first disbursement of these funds under section 2001(b)(1) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) for the purposes of meeting the immediate needs of students experiencing homelessness, including the identification, enrollment, participation, and success of children and youth experiencing homelessness, and the provision of wrap-around services in light of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

USED required ARP Homeless I funds to be administered by the Office of the State Coordinator for the Education of Homeless Children and Youth (EHCY) and in a manner consistent with all the requirements of the EHCY program. Under the McKinney-Vento Act, EHCY funds must be distributed via a competitive grant process; therefore, ARP Homeless I funds were also awarded to LEAs through a competitive grant process in the Grants Management System (GMS). All LEAs were eligible to apply for ARP Homeless I funds and applications were based on existing EHCY subgrant requirements.
