Career exploration pilot updates - feedback from Vermont Afterschool

- King Street is currently running the program started 6/24/24 (until 8/16/24).
- MVU (Swanton) will be running the week of July 22nd (futures week). Having a career fair at the end of the week. Running out of St. Albans tech center.
- CVSU is now doing two sites Williamstown and Northfield.
 - Williamstown week of August 5th.
 - Northfield 2 weeks starting July 22nd.
- Training in May and then follow up meeting in June thus far all staff appointed and trained in each site; going well.
- Checked in on needs for the sites: outreach to employers CVSU sites were working together; King Street may want a little assistance.



• Demographics survey shared – initial report indicates around 10 students per site serving rising 6th to 9th grade students.

Discussion with DJ Masi:

- Reviewed pilot model for Lamoille youth and business partnership mentoring program he is facilitating within HireAbility.
- Discussed transportation, ask for employers, connection to the various career opportunities within one business, working in collaboration with schools.
- DJ will provide updates as the pilot continues.

Other Business

- Reviewed the interest form on the VT Afterschool website we have not had a strong response – discussed how to best contact the individuals and follow-up practices.
 - Decision Katie will communicate with anyone younger than 14 years old; DOL and HireAbility VT will cc Katie on communications and make three attempts to connect.
