SUBJECT: Non-traditional Program Status Changes
DATE: August 1, 2013

On January 28, 2013, the National Alliance for Partnerships in Equity (NAPE) released an updated non-traditional crosswalk. NAPE conducted this work in collaboration with the National Research Center for Career Technical Education (NRCCTE). The prior crosswalk was released in 2007. Our analysis of the changes to the crosswalk have led to the following changes that will be in effect starting in the 2013-14 school year:

The Agency’s policy is to monitor changes to “Perkins IV Table 3, Nontraditional CIP to Career Cluster Crosswalk” as adopted by the Office for Vocational and Adult Education (OVAE) and published on the Perkins Collaborative Resource Network website: [Accountability Crosswalk](#)

Any changes to a program’s non-traditional status will solely be a result of information found in the Table 3 crosswalk. Changes are unlikely to take place on a yearly basis as the crosswalks use labor market information trends to support any change.
