- Presumptive Contact: student/staff who shared a classroom with another person who tested positive for COVID-19.
- Close Contact (3-6 ft, 15 mins or more): not a category in school exposures anymore, only through community exposure.
- Ongoing Household Exposure: student/staff who are in ongoing contact with a
 positive COVID case within the household.

Protocol for individual who tests positive for COVID-19 (in or out of school)



Student tests positive for COVID-19

- Stay home/go home and isolate for 5 days.
- Notify any close contacts.


RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER DAY 5 IF:

- 1. Symptoms improve
- 2. Fever-free without fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours
- 3. Wear a mask around others through Day 10
- 4.*The Vermont Department of Health also strongly recommends that positive individuals get tested on Day 4 and 5 with antigen tests
- 5. If a student meets criteria 1-3, they do not need a negative test to return to school.

Protocol for asymptomatic close contact (Contact outside of school)



Student is asymptomatic, but has been identified as a close contact of a COVID positive person outside of school (e.g. an indoor playdate or birthday party). Is the student vaccinated (completed primary series of Pfizer vaccine)?






Protocol for Ongoing Household Exposure or individuals with continuous household exposure:





Protocol for Asymptomatic Presumptive Contact (student/staff who shared a classroom with another person who tested positive for COVID-19)



If a student tests positive, they should stay home from school and follow the protocol for a positive case.

If student becomes symptomatic they should stay home from school and follow the protocol for a symptomatic student
