

Early Childhood Transition Information

This Indicator measures the percentage of children transitioning from Children's Integrated Services-Early Intervention (CIS-EI), known as Part C, to Part B (IEP Services for students ages 3 to 21), who have IEPs developed and implemented by their 3rd birthdays.

Measurement:

- a. # of children who have been served in Part C and referred to Part B for Part B eligibility determination.
- b. # of those referred determined to be NOT eligible and whose eligibilities were determined prior to their third birthday.
- c. # of those found eligible who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthday.
- d. # of children for whom parent refusal to provide consent caused delays in evaluation or initial services or to whom exceptions under 34 CFR §300.301(d) applied.
- e. # of children who were referred to Part C less than 90 days before their third birthday.

Account for children included in a, but not included in b, c, d, or e. Indicate the range of days beyond the third birthday when eligibility was determined and the IEP developed and the reasons for the delays.

Percent = [(c) divided by (a - b - d - e)] times 100.

The data used is gathered from Supervisory Unions on a rotating basis, with each being monitored once every 6 years.
