Mediations:

no agreement

18 of 25 mediations resulted in agreement: 18 ÷ 25 = 72%

What do Complaints mean?

- Parent/LEA disagreement is not always indicative of non-compliance
- Most common reason for complaint is that parents don't feel heard
- Reasons why a family may/may not make a complaint
 - Fear of retribution
 - Lack of trust in the complaint system
 - Lack of knowledge of how to engage with the complaint system
