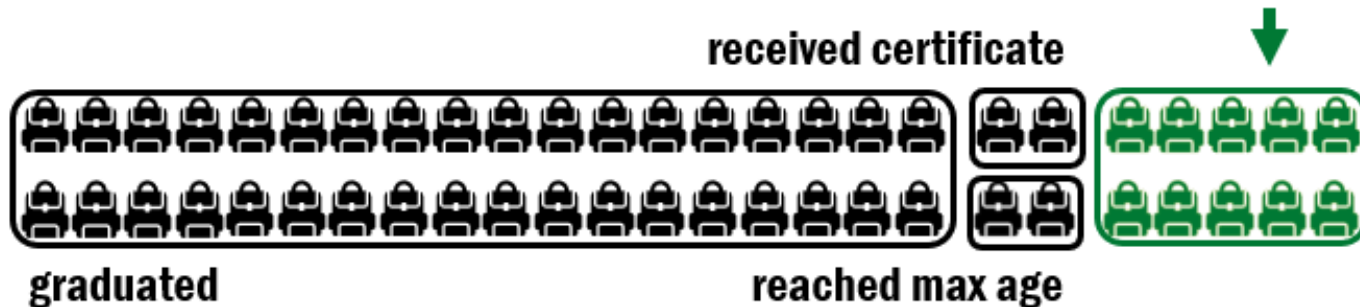
- Indicator 2 examines the percent of youth with IEPs dropping out of high school.

Measurement

- **Measurement:** % of exiting youth w/ IEPs age 14-21 who dropped out (rather than graduated, aged out, or received a certificate)

Youth with IEPs Ages 14-21 who exited school during the year:

10 of 50 exiting students dropped out: $10 \div 50 = 20\%$



The numbers in the measurement imagery are not real, and are just examples for illustrative purposes

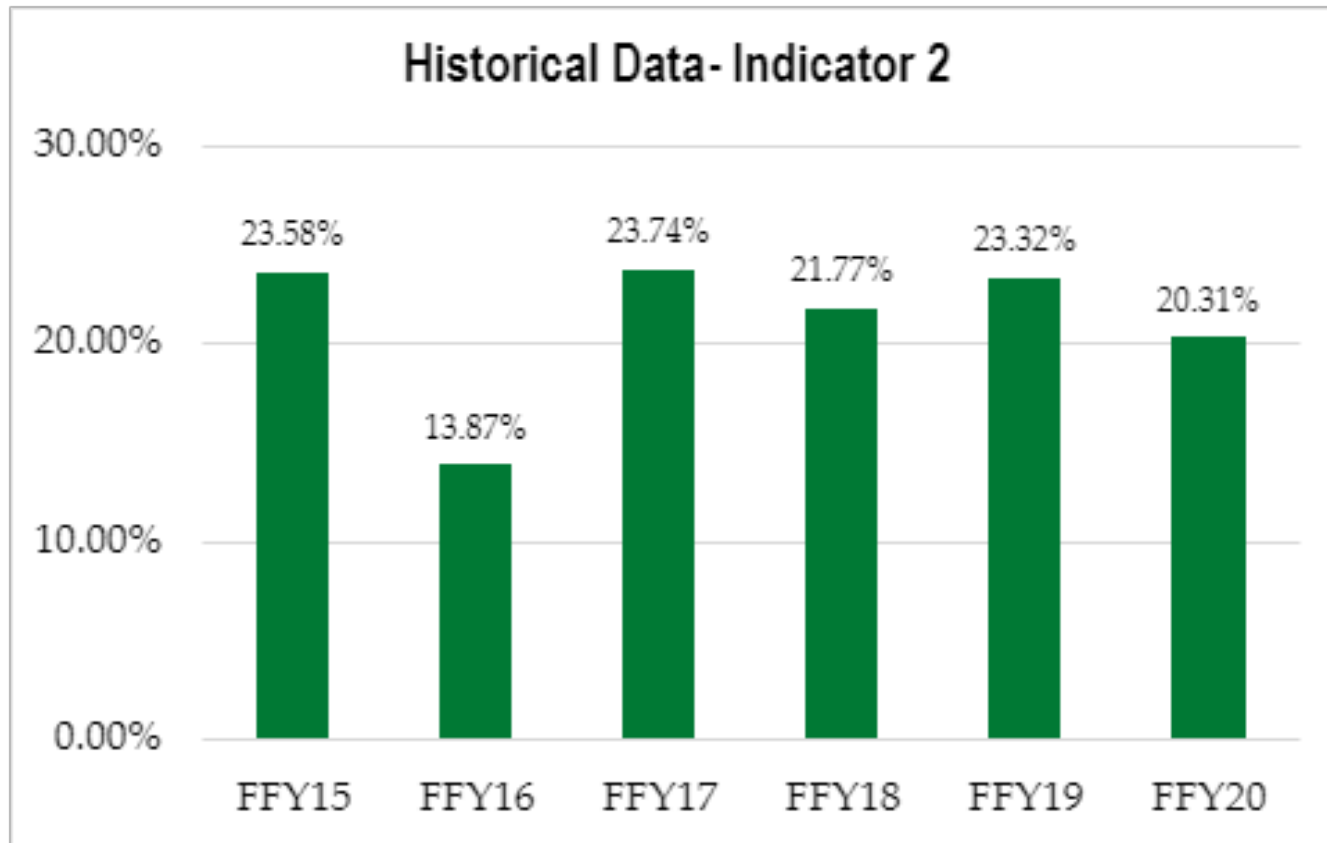

Rationale and Parameters

- Setting Targets for the next 6 years
 - FFY20, FFY21, FFY22, FFY23, FFY24, FFY25
- FFY20-FFY24 targets can be below, same or better than baseline
- FFY25 has to be better than baseline
- They can improve at any point, every point or just in FFY25
