"Sap Season"

Before Viewing

- What do you predict the story will be about?
- What is "sap"?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your predictions, so far?
- Why are they tapping trees for sap?
- What are the steps involved in tapping the tree?
- What types of trees are they tapping? What kind of syrup are the making?

After Viewing

- What problem did Molly encounter in this episode? What was the creative solution?
- What was your favorite part of this story? Why?
- Learn more, at this site about birch syrup and the process for making it.
