# "Welcome Home Balto"

# **Before Viewing**

- What do you predict the story will be about?
- What are "mushers"?
- What does "perilous" mean?

# During Viewing

- Is the story matching your predictions, so far?
- Why do you think they built a Balto statue in New York?
- What do you think Molly and Tooey will do, since they learned there is not a statue of Balto in Alaska?
- Do you think they will continue to head into the blizzard?
- What words would you use to describe the characters?

# After Viewing

- What was the problem Molly and Tooey encountered in this episode? How did they solve the problem?
- How was the situation in this episode similar to the story of Balto?
- What did Molly learn about Balto?
- Why was Balto a hero?

#### Reading Connection Activity: Read the story of Balto the Sled Dog, Facts about Siberian Huskies

*Writing Connection Activity:* Use what you have learned in the story and facts page to write an informational piece about Balto and/or Siberian Huskies. You may wish to use this <u>paragraph structure</u> <u>graphic organizer</u> to help you plan your work.
