

Discussion Questions and Activities for *Pinkalicious*

“Amazing Sled Run”

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is wrong with the first sledding hill? How do the kids work together to make the sled ride more fun?
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? Why doesn't Peter want to go down the sled run? How does the “test run” solve the problem?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Write about a time you were afraid to try something new. What did you do to face your fear? Were you glad you did?
- Use found objects to create a marble maze.

“Frost Fairy”

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? Why is it a problem that the frost fairy slept all night? How are Pinkalicious and Peter helping?
- How does helping the frost fairy create a new problem for the Pinkertons? How does thinking about hugs help solve this problem?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Imagine what it would be like to be Felix. Write a journal entry from the point of view of a frost fairy.
