Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? What is the RESOLUTION (the end of the problem)?

After Viewing

- Why is the episode called “Best Day Ever”? Use evidence from the episode to support your thoughts.
- Write about a time you were disappointed. What happened? What did you do to cheer yourself up? Did it work?

Activities

- Listening to one of your favorite songs, make up your own dance.
