



Discussion Questions and Activities for *Pinkalicious*

"Pinkfoot"

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?
- Define "legend."

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What happens when the Pinkertons are sleeping in their tent?
- How does Daddy describe Pinkfoot when he tells the Legend of Pinkfoot? How is she different in real life?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

• Daddy tells Pinkalicious and Peter the Legend of Pinkfoot. Write your own legend about an imaginary creature. Illustrate your story with a drawing of your creature.

"Flossie the Mossling"

Before Viewing

• What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? Why does the water music stop? How does Pinkalicious try to help?
- What is wrong with each of Pinkalicious' water music solutions?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Flossie calls the sounds of the stream "water music." What other music can you hear in nature?
