"Sand Palace"

Before Viewing

• What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? What happens to Pinkalicious' first sand palace? What about her second one?
- How is a sand palace different from a sand castle?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Design your own sand palace. Write a paragraph describing what you want your palace to look like. Then, draw your palace or build it out of objects you find around the house.
- What does Pinkalicious learn about accepting help?
- Pinkalicious learns that working together can be better than competing against her friends. What makes working together better?

• What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? Why are Pinkalicious and Peter bringing Henrietta and Fred to the zoo? What problems does the monkey cause? How does Pinkalicious finally get Henrietta back?
