Good afternoon,

The draft State Board of Education report and an addendum document are attached. By State Board rule, you have 30 days to review the report for accuracy purpose. If, however, you can review the report and send your response via email within the next two weeks, we may be able to get the school's renewal request on the Independent School Subcommittee's March 1, 2023 agenda. Please do not make corrections to the actual draft report, just provide a list of any changes needed for accuracy purposes.

The new independent school process requires that the draft reports first go to a State Board Subcommittee. At their meeting, they will want to speak to you briefly about the report and perhaps ask questions regarding your school; therefore, you will need to be available for a short time on the day/time they are meeting. Generally, it takes about 10 minutes or so.

The full State Board of Education meeting is scheduled for March 15, 2023. The Subcommittee of the State Board will introduce your school to the full State Board at this meeting. Again, we ask that you make yourself available to speak to the full Board if they have questions.

Once we have received your response to the draft report and have signed the required addendum, you will be notified about how to remotely connect to both the Subcommittee and full State Board meeting on the Teams platform.

The addendum is a new document now required because of the independent school rules changing on May 10, 2022. Some of the changes went into effect immediately.

Looking forward to hearing from you regarding this matter.
