

EXPEDITIONARY SCHOOL AT BLACK RIVER

- I. Provision of Special Education Services Students with local LEA (Two Rivers Supervisory Union)
 - A. ESBR and TRSU agree to work together collaboratively to ensure the student's services are provided in accordance with state and federal law.
 - B. Upon enrollment, the ESBR Support Services Coordinator will convene a meeting with TRSU's Out of District Placement manager and IEP or 504 Team within 30 days, and before the start of school as soon as is practicable.
 - C. The IEP/504 Team will develop a Services Plan for meeting the goals of the IEP/504. Two Rivers will provide Special Education services as determined in the services plan.
 - D. If TRSU cannot provide Special Education services as determined in the Services Plan, ESBR will contract with a qualified outside provider to provide these services.
 - E. The ESBR Support Services Coordinator will ensure that all teachers receive a copy of the Services Plan and 504 Plan and a review of accommodations needed for students in their class. This is a confidential document based on need to know.
 - F. ESBR will share school progress of the student and all other pertinent data throughout the year.
