The Commission on Independent Schools of the New England Association of Schools and Colleges met on November 7-8, 2022. At that meeting, the Focused Visit Report prepared by Commission member Randy Smith was reviewed and accepted.

Additionally, the Commission has requested a Special Progress Report to include a financial update looking specifically at long-term financial planning (3 to 5 years) due September 15, 2023. Upon receipt of the Special Progress Report, a staff follow-up will be scheduled.
