

Legislative initiatives re State Board of Education, 2012-2020

May 2012	Act 98 of 2012	eliminated SBE authority over Secretary and AoE; required staff “... <i>who shall report to the Board</i> ”; inserted “... <i>establish and advance education policy</i> ...”
May 2014	Act 92 of 2014	clarified “... <i>Board shall adopt rules</i> ...”; mostly house-keeping changes
June 2015	Act 46 of 2015	“... <i>the State Board shall adopt State Plan ... merging and realigning districts and supervisory unions where necessary.</i> ”
Jan 2017	S.24 / H.117	transfer rule-making authority from SBE to AoE (<i>bills introduced but not acted on</i>)
May 2017	Act 49 of 2017	“ <i>State Board shall suspend further Rule 2200 rulemaking</i> ”
May 2018	Act 173 of 2018	“... <i>State Board shall adopt rules to implement the Act</i> ...”
Jan 2019	S.166 / H.340	dissolve SBE, transfer all duties and authorities to AoE (<i>bills introduced but not acted on</i>)
Jan 2020	H.660	repeal all duties & authorities of State Board of Education, 1 July 2021, based on recommendation of Sunset Commission <u>(actively moving through House committees for approval)</u>
Jan 2020	DR 20-0777	redefine duties & authorities of State Board of Education (<i>under consideration in Senate Committee on Education</i>)
