   (also known as the Ethnic Studies
   and Social Equity Working Group)



# What is the purpose of the Act 1 Working Group?

 To review the current Vermont State Education Standards and make recommendations for updates

#### **AND**

 To review State statutes, State Board rules, and school district and supervisory union policies that concern or impact standards for student performance or curriculum used in schools

Not sure if it's spring...


April 14<sup>th</sup> vote on current EQS.

Each comment related to a paragraph was incorporated into one document and working group members had access to all submissions



**Promote critical thinking** regarding the history, contribution, and perspectives of ethnic groups and social groups;











include content and related instructional materials and methods that enable students to explore safely questions of identity and membership in ethnic groups and social groups, race equality, and racism; and
