On June 25, 2020, Residential Licensing and Special Investigations (RLSI) sent a letter to Kurn Hattin outlining a proposed path for closure of Kurn Hattin's Residential Treatment Program (RTP) license. This letter included four criteria to be satisfied, as affirmed Kurn Hattin, in order to close on July 15, 2020.

On July 22, 2020, RLSI received written confirmation that Kurn Hattin had satisfied three of the four criteria and RLSI communicated with Kurn Hattin regarding the fourth item, to remove reference of being licensed as an RTP from the website and future literature. RLSI has since verified the fourth item has been satisfied and we are now in agreement with your request to close this license. This letter serves as formal notice of license closure, effective as of this date.
