I am now in receipt of the teach-out agreement that you have executed with Green Mountain College (GMC) and the letter documenting the New England Commission of Higher Education's (NECHE) approval of this teach-out plan. Your forwarding of these documents follows recent conversations during which you informed me of Prescott College's intent to serve as the preferred teach-out partner for GMC as it prepares to cease operations after the spring semester of 2019.

It is clear from the agreement that this new partnership has been built on a longstanding relationship, with a commonality of mission and purpose, that clearly underscores your interest in assisting GMC. My review of Prescott's current status with HLC leaves me with no concern about your capacity to fulfill the terms of the teach-out agreement.
