3. Log in with your Patient ID.
4. Register for a testing event.

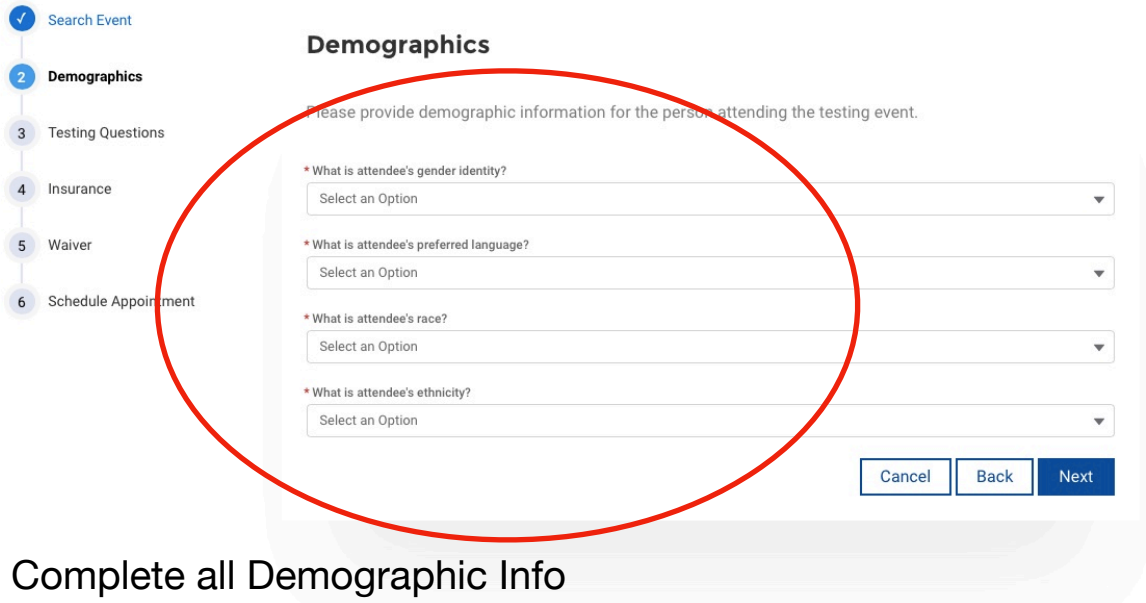

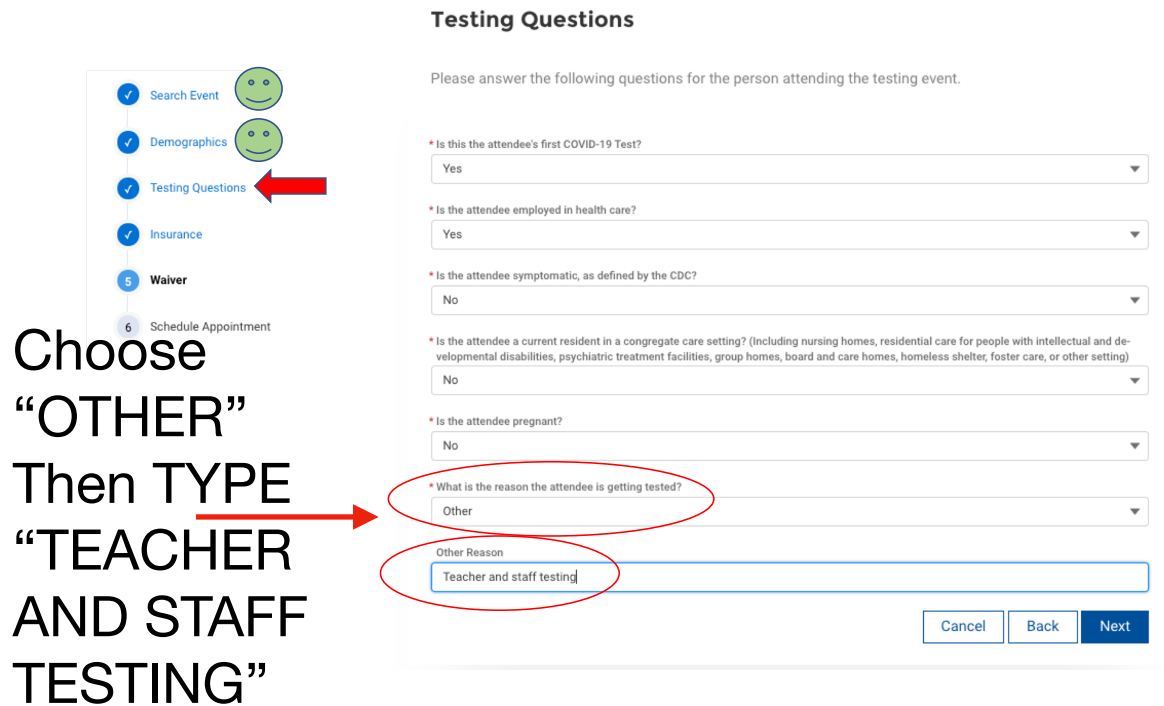

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19.

Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately: trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, inability to wake or stay awake, bluish lips or face.

Click NO. IF you are symptomatic on the day of testing, you are expected to stay at home. Do not come in to be tested.

Choose any available time. The time you choose DOES NOT MATTER. You can come during your school's testing window.

This confirms your appointment. Be sure you are scheduled for HUUSD testing.

You should receive a confirmation email from VERMONT AHS once you are registered for testing. If you do not receive a confirmation email listing HUUSD as the testing location, you are NOT registered.
