**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:** Policy F2 - Recency of Study

**BACKGROUND:**

The AOE felt that the Licensing Committee should review Policy F2 on Recency of Study, given that it was last review in February of 2015.

Any applicant applying for an initial license (traditional route) with a recommendation for licensure that is older than ten (10) years must follow Policy F2.

Also, any applicant applying through reciprocity with a life-time license with an initial date older than ten years, must show updated study according to Policy F2 (90 hours of new learning of which 30 hours must align with the content knowledge and performance standards of the endorsement within the last five preceding the initial application).

**For Discussion:**

- Should Policy F2 remain the same with the requirement of ten years from recommendation? The same would apply to initial licensure through reciprocity with a lifetime recommendation.
- Should Policy F2 mirror the five year licensure cycle of a Level II renewal? Meaning any licensure recommendation or lifetime license with an initial date of more than five years would need to show recency of study.

## **POLICY F2**

### **Policy On Recency Of Study**

#### A. Updated knowledge and skills

1. An applicant shall meet the following requirements for updated knowledge and skills when there is a time lapse of ten (10) or more years between the time of recommendation for licensure and application for licensure.

a. Six (6) credits/ 90 hours of professional learning in the endorsement area recommended for licensure, within the last five (5) years are required.

b. Two (2) credits/30 hours of the six (6) credits/90 hours must align with the content and knowledge standards of the endorsement.

c. Activities that qualify can be found in SB/H2 – Activities that Qualify for Professional Learning Credit.
