

Indicator 5 – Education Environments (Ages 5-in-Kindergarten to 21)

Reported in both the statewide and local APR.

Measure A: The percent of IEP students ages 5-in-kindergarten to 21 who are in the regular classroom for 80% or more of their day.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure A} = \frac{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21 inside the regular classroom for 80\% or more of the day}}{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21}} \times 100$$

Measure B: The percent of IEP students ages 5-in-kindergarten to 21 who are in the regular classroom for less than 40% of their day.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure B} = \frac{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21 inside the regular classroom for less than 40\% of the day}}{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21}} \times 100$$

Measure C: The percent of IEP students ages 5-in-kindergarten to 21 who are placed in Separate School, Residential or Homebound/Hospital settings.

$$\text{Indicator 5 Measure C} = \frac{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21 in a separate school, residential facility, homebound or hospitalized}}{\text{Number of students with IEPs ages 5 in kindergarten to 21}} \times 100$$

It should be noted that the sum of measures A, B & C may be less than 100%, as there are other educational environments that are not the subject of these APR measures.
