

Indicator 12 – Early Childhood Transition

Reported in both the statewide and local APR.

Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3, who are found eligible for Part B, and who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthdays.

Categories:

- a. Children who have been served in Part C and referred to Part B for Part B eligibility determination.
- b. Referred children determined to be NOT eligible and whose eligibility was determined prior to their third birthdays.
- c. Children found eligible who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthdays.
- d. Children for whom parent refusal to provide consent caused delays in evaluation or initial services or to whom exceptions under 34 CFR §300.301(d) applied.
- e. Children determined to be eligible for early intervention services under Part C less than 90 days before their third birthdays.
- f. Children whose parents chose to continue early intervention services beyond the child's third birthday through a State's policy under 34 CFR §303.211 or a similar State option.
