


## Gender & Sexuality

- EMOTION ATTRACTION What gender identity do you tend love?





#### **Green zone**

- "Good" neighborhoods
- Deeds "Only Whites"
- Mortgages subsidized
- Insurance provided
- Anti-poverty zoning

- "Bad" neighborhoods
- Mortgages not subsidized
- Insurance not provided
- No zoning protection against corporate pollution

#### Sources of wealth accrual


- Real estate
